**The Same Stuff Used For Hockey Pucks**... Teams in all three NASCAR series will run the same tire codes at Phoenix this weekend, though the Sprint Cup and Nationwide tires will be branded “Goodyear Eagle,” while the Camping World Truck tires will be branded “Goodyear Wrangler”. This is the same combination of left- and right-side tire codes that Sprint Cup and Nationwide teams ran at this track in April (also used in Sprint Cup and Nationwide competition at Richmond in 2009; Camping World Trucks have run this tire at Milwaukee, Memphis and New Hampshire) As on most NASCAR ovals one mile or less in length, teams will not run inner liners in their tires at Phoenix.
