



LL77 – Order: 15 (+3.921 sec)-4 (4.313)-13. #51 Kyle Busch has dropped to fourth, 6.490 seconds behind. Crew reports that he did not take tires during the Lap 35 pit stops and that they are losing grip.

LL90 – Yellow Flag #3 -- #50 Wheeler Boys stops on track.

LL92 – Selected Pit Stops: #15, #33 – 4TF (air pressure); #51 – 4TF (air pressure to right rear); #88, #5 – 4TF; #4 – 4TF (air pressure to right front); #13 – 4TF (trackbar); #6 – 4TF (wedge taken out); #25 – 2TF; #16 – 4TF (trackbar, wedge, air pressure).

LL94 – Green Flag. #4 Harvick takes the lead low entering T3.

LL110 – Order: 4 (+0.871 sec.)-15 (+2.385)-51 (+6.067)-33-25

LL114 -- #6 heads to the garage; crew reports possible broken camshaft.

LL121 – Yellow Flag #4 -- #22 Tim George Jr. hits the wall and continues.

LL126 – Green Flag. #4 leads from 51-15-33-25.

LL134 – Yellow Flag #5 – after being bumped in the rear by #88 Matt Crafton, #71 Kevin Conway glances off the wall in T2 and continues to pits. Leaders stay on the track, sacrificing the grip of new tires for track position.

LL139 – Green Flag. Order: 4-51-15-33-13.

LL145 – Yellow Flag #6 -- #10 James Buescher does a half spin and hits the wall in T4.

LL149 – Green Flag. Order: 4-51-15-33-13.

LL150 – Yellow Flag #7 -- #61 Brett Thompson is bumped and hits the outside wall on the main straight. **#4 Kevin Harvick wins the Lucas Oil 150 for the second consecutive year.** Unofficial margin of victory over #51 is 0.168 seconds. Unofficial average speed 99.746 mph. *This is Harvick's seventh NASCAR win (and fourth in the Camping World Truck Series) at PIR; he has won more NASCAR races at PIR than any other driver. With his fourth Truck Series win at PIR, Harvick takes exclusive possession of the top spot in Truck Series victories at Phoenix* (previously, he was tied with Jack Sprague at three).

This is only Harvick's fifth career Camping World Truck Series victory; earlier this year he won at Martinsville. Harvick has twice scored back-to-back wins in Truck Series races at PIR (2002 and 2003; 2008 and 2009). Harvick and Kyle Busch are the only drivers to have won in all three of NASCAR's national touring series (Sprint Cup, Nationwide Series and Camping World Trucks) at PIR. Today's win was also the third consecutive Truck Series win at PIR for Chevrolet.
