



Lucas Oil 150 Pole Progression

First truck out -- #15 Aric Almirola	27.650 seconds
10 th truck out -- #51 Kyle Busch	27.632
12 th truck out -- #4 Kevin Harvick	27.543
22 nd truck out -- #13 Johnny Sauter	27.477

#13 Johnny Sauter wins the pole for the Lucas Oil 150 with a speed of 131.019 mph (27.477 seconds – not a record). This is Sauter’s second career pole in the Camping World Truck Series (after Texas-1 2009) and first pole at PIR. He scored his first career Camping World Truck Series victory five races ago (Las Vegas).

Start of the Lucas Oil 150 at 8:18 p.m.

Leader Lap 1 – #4 Kevin Harvick holds the outside line and leads from #13 Johnny Sauter.

LL3 – #13 Sauter leads.

LL4 – #51 Kyle Busch takes second from #4 Harvick

LL7 – Yellow Flag. #4 Harvick does a half spin exiting Turn 4 after side-by-side contact with #15 Aric Almirola. #4 restarts and continues to pits.

LL11 – Green Flag. Order: 13-51-15-33-25-88-16-60-07-30.

LL34 – Yellow Flag #2 -- #90 Brad Sweet spins entering T3 and continues

LL35 – Selected Pit Stops: #51- Fuel, no adjustments; #13, #33, #88, #14 #5, #24 – 4 Tires, Fuel; #4 , #15 – 4TF (plus air pressure adjustment); #25, #30 – 4TF (1 round up on trackbar); #60 – Right side tires and Fuel; #6 – Fuel (1 round up on track bar).

LL37 – #33 Ron Hornaday makes a second stop for a refueling infraction. He drops to 22nd (last car on lead lap); #4 makes a second stop for a track bar adjustment.

LL38 – Green Flag. Order: 51-6-15-60-88-81-5-16-25-13

LL47 – Order: 15 (+1.438 sec.)-51 (+3.723)-6 (4.218)-4-60-13-88-81-16-25

LL58 – Order: 15 (+2.802 sec.)-51 (+3.797)-4 (+4.132)-13-88

LL60 – #15 leads by 3.120 sec (first lead of more than 3 seconds)

LL62 – #33 Hornaday is now 15th, 16.407 seconds behind the leader.
