OFFICIAL RULES FOR THE “PHOENIX RACEWAY® JUNIOR RACER PROGRAM CONTEST”

CONTEST PERIOD: The Phoenix Raceway® Junior Racer Program Contest (“Contest”) begins on August 16, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. Mountain Time (“MT”) and ends on November 15, 2027, at 11:59 p.m. MT (the “Contest Period”). The Contest Period consists of fifteen (15) Monthly Periods, with the first Monthly Period beginning at 9:00 a.m. MT on August 16, 2026, and ending at 11:59:59 p.m. MT on September 15, 2026. The next Monthly Period begins at 12:00 a.m. MT on September 16, 2026, and ends at 11:59:59 p.m. MT on October 15, 2026. Subsequent Monthly Periods follow this same structure, with the final Monthly Period beginning at 12:00 a.m. MT on October 16, 2027, and ending at 11:59:59 p.m. MT on November 15, 2027.

ELIGIBILITY: Contest is open to legal residents of Arizona who are between the ages of eight (8) years old and sixteen (16) years old at the time of entry and who actively participate in a local or regional youth wheeled sport racing league in Arizona (“Contestant”). A “wheeled sport” is defined as any sport that uses a wheeled device for forward motion and maneuvering, which could include, but is not limited to, karting, quarter midgets, BMX, motocross, skateboarding, and/or roller skating. A parent or legal guardian must submit the entry with the consent form on behalf of an eligible child. Employees of Phoenix Speedway, LLC, and its parents, subsidiaries, limited liability and affiliated companies, advertising and promotion agencies, and each of their respective family members (parent, child, spouse, sibling and their respective spouses, regardless of where they reside), and members of their households, whether or not related, are not eligible to enter or win. Contest is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws. Void where prohibited by law.

HOW TO ENTER: No purchase necessary to enter. At or around the beginning of the Contest Period, Administrator will provide entry instructions, parental consent forms, and these Official Rules for the Contest on its website at www.phoenixraceway.com/juniorracer/. Either on his or her own or with the help of a parent, Contestant will create a short video (1-3 minutes) OR a short essay (250-500 words) identifying the Contestant and the wheeled sport league in which Contestant participates, as well as answering the following questions:

- o Tell us how racing became part of your life and why it is important to you.
- o What are your goals for the future in racing? What inspires you to keep pushing toward those dreams?
- o Why should you be selected as the Phoenix Raceway Junior Racer of the Month?

A parent or legal guardian of Contestant must e-mail the completed entry form and parent and/or legal guardian written consent form, along with the video or essay entry to juniorracer@phoenixraceway.com during the Contest Period (collectively the “Entry”) for one (1) Entry into the Contest. All Entries must be received by November 15, 2027, at 11:59:59 p.m. MT to be considered. Entries will be considered in the Monthly Period in which they are received, as well as all subsequent Monthly Periods, so long as the Entry has not been selected as a winner. Entries generated by script, macro, AI or other automated or mechanical means or by any means which subvert the entry process are void. Limit one (1) Entry per Contestant. A parent may submit entries for more than one eligible Contestant, but may only submit one entry per Contestant for the entire Contest Period. Entries received from any person in excess of the limitation will be void. All Entries become the sole property of the Administrator and will not be returned. Released Parties (as defined below) are not responsible for lost, late, stolen, garbled, incomplete, damaged, delayed, illegible, mutilated, misdirected, or postage-due Entries or mail. Incomplete, illegible, or fraudulent entries not considered.

REQUIREMENTS OF ENTRIES:

Entry may not contain, as determined by the Administrator, in its sole discretion, any content that:

- is sexually explicit or suggestive; unnecessarily violent or derogatory of any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional or age group; profane or pornographic; contains nudity;
- promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing); promotes any activities that may appear unsafe or dangerous; promotes any particular political agenda or message;

- is obscene or offensive; endorses any form of hate or hate group; appears to duplicate any other submitted Entries;
- defames, misrepresents, or contains disparaging remarks about other people or companies;
- contains trademarks, logos, or trade dress (such as distinctive packaging or building exteriors/interiors) owned by others, without permission; contains any personal identification, such as license plate numbers, personal names, e-mail addresses or street addresses;
- contains copyrighted materials owned by others (including music, photographs, sculptures, paintings, and other works of art or images published on or in websites, television, movies, or other media), without permission;
- contains materials embodying the names, likenesses, voices, or other indicia identifying any person other than Contestant and parent/guardian, including, without limitation, celebrities and/or other public or private figures, living or dead;
- contains look-alikes of celebrities or other public or private figures, living or dead;
- communicates messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or good will to which we wish to associate; and/or
- violates any law.

Entry must be the original work of the Contestant and parent/guardian, may not have been previously published, may not have won previous awards, and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity. By submitting an Entry, Contestant and parent/legal guardian warrant and represent that he/she and any persons appearing or who are identifiable in the Entry consent to the submission and use of the Entry in the Contest and to its use as otherwise set forth herein.

OWNERSHIP/USE OF ENTRIES: By submitting an Entry, the Contestant and parent/legal guardian agree that if Contestant is selected as a winner in the Contest, then Contestant and parent/legal guardian assign all rights in and to the video/essay and other materials submitted in the Entry to Administrator, so that Administrator shall own the Entry submitted (including all rights embodied therein) such that Administrator and its designees may exploit, edit, modify, display, distribute, and create derivative works from the Entry and all elements of such Entry, including, without limitation, the names and likenesses of any persons or locations embodied therein, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, worldwide, in perpetuity without compensation, permission or notification to Contestant, parent/legal guardian or any third party. If requested by Administrator, winning Contestant and the parent/legal guardian of a winner must execute appropriate documentation assigning all right and title to the Entry to Administrator as a condition to receiving any prize. If the parent/legal guardian of each potential winner does not wish to assign his/her minor child's rights to the Entry to Administrator, that potential winner will be disqualified from the Contest, and Administrator will offer the prize to the next runner-up for that Monthly Period.

DETERMINATION OF WINNERS: There will be a total of fifteen (15) winners in the Contest, with one (1) winner selected for each Monthly Period during the Contest Period. Following the close of each Monthly Period, a panel of judges from Administrator will review all eligible Entries received by Administrator as of the closing date of that Monthly Period, and will select three finalists, whose entries will then be reviewed and scored by a separate internal selection committee to select one featured Junior Racer for that Monthly Period. Non-winning Entries from prior Monthly Periods carry over and will be considered in subsequent Monthly Periods. Note that if your video or essay exceeds the length limits above, your Entry will not be disqualified, but the judges will base their scoring on the first three minutes of the video or the first 500 words of the essay, so you will want to be sure to address all of the questions and provide the important information within those limits. All judging will be based on the following criteria, as demonstrated in the Entry video or essay:

- **Passion for Racing:** Entry demonstrates genuine enthusiasm for racing and explains how racing became part of their life. Shows commitment, excitement, and personal connection to the sport;

- **Future Goals & Determination:** Entry clearly articulates future racing goals and explains what motivates them to pursue those dreams. Demonstrates perseverance, dedication, and growth mindset;
- **Why They Should Be Selected:** Entry provides a compelling case for being named Junior Racer of the Month;
- **Creativity & Authenticity:** Entry submission feels personal, sincere, and unique. Storytelling is engaging and reflects the Contestant's genuine personality and experiences.

The non-winning finalists and other non-winning Entries for that Monthly Period will remain eligible for consideration in future Monthly Periods, although the scoring for each Monthly Period will return to zero for all Entries. Limit one prize per Contestant throughout the entire Contest Period. Administrator reserves the right not to name a winner and award a prize for a particular Monthly Period if, in its sole discretion, it does not receive a sufficient number of eligible and qualified Entries. Prize awards are subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Official Rules.

WINNER NOTIFICATION: Parent or legal guardian of a potential winning Contestant will be contacted via email at the e-mail address provided in the Entry within approximately two weeks of the close of the Monthly Period for which the Contestant has been selected as a potential winner, and will be required to execute and return a declaration of winner, a publicity release for their minor child (except where prohibited), a liability release and a copy of parent/guardian's valid personal identification card bearing his/her photograph, name, age, and address within five (5) days of date of notification. The execution of additional releases and/or waivers of liability required by Phoenix Speedway, LLC, and/or any other applicable sanctioning body or prize provider may also be required and must be returned within the time period specified by such entities, as appropriate. If a prize notification is undeliverable, or if the parent/legal guardian of a potential winner fails to sign and return required documentation within the specified time period, or if a potential winner is discovered to be ineligible or to have violated these Official Rules, or if a potential winner declines the prize for any reason, that potential winner will be disqualified and, at Administrator's sole discretion, the prize may be awarded to the eligible entrant with the next highest score according to the criteria above. Administrator reserves the right not to award a prize if it is unable to confirm a winner for that Monthly Period after five attempts. If a prize is forfeited for any reason after the prize has already been confirmed and awarded, then no alternate winner will be selected. Administrator reserves the right to award the prize in the name of minor's parent or legal guardian who will be responsible for fulfilling all requirements imposed on winners set forth herein.

PRIZES: One (1) winner per Monthly Period, for a total of fifteen (15) winners during the entire Contest Period, will each be recognized as the Phoenix Raceway Junior Racer for the applicable Monthly Period and will appear on the Phoenix Raceway website and social media pages through the end of 2027. Winners from the Monthly Periods leading up to each NASCAR Cup Series Race held at Phoenix Raceway will be featured in the program for that race weekend. Each winner will also receive two (2) grandstand tickets to the next NASCAR Cup Series™ race at Phoenix Raceway® following the win and a commemorative t-shirt and certificate to honor the achievement. Approximate retail value of each prize is between \$205-\$250, depending on which race winner attends. Total value of all prizes is between \$3075-\$3750. If winner and parent/guardian is unable to attend the applicable NASCAR Cup Series™ race, parent/guardian may substitute tickets to the corresponding O'Reilly Auto Parts Series or Craftsman Truck Series race for that weekend. Winner and parent/guardian will not receive the value of any difference between the approximate value of the prize stated in these rules and the value of the tickets actually awarded. T-shirts are generally available in standard youth and adult sizes. The color, style, design and all other details of prize t-shirts are in the sole discretion of Administrator and are subject to availability. Administrator reserves the right to provide a different size from the requested size in its sole discretion if the requested size is unavailable for any reason. All applicable federal, state, and local taxes, and any other expenses associated with prize acceptance and use not specifically listed herein as being provided are the responsibility of each winner. Prizes are awarded "as is" with no warranty or guarantee, either express or implied by Administrator. No substitution, transfer or cash redemption of prizes is permitted, except by Administrator, which reserves the right to substitute a prize (or portion thereof) with one of comparable or greater value. All prize details are at Administrator's sole discretion. All tickets are subject to the terms and conditions generally applicable thereto, and winners, parents/guardians and other guests must comply with all policies and procedures of Phoenix Raceway®, NASCAR, and any other relevant entities. Prize consists of tickets only. Winner and parent/guardian are solely responsible for all costs

and expenses associated with attending the race, including but not limited to travel, accommodations, parking, food and beverages, souvenirs, and other personal expenses. Released Parties shall have no liability or responsibility if any ticketed event is cancelled, postponed or rescheduled for any reason. There shall be no substitution of prize or compensation in the event of cancellation of a race or other unavailability of the prize or portions of the prize. Released Parties shall have no liability or responsibility, and there shall be no compensation or prize substitution, if winner and parent/guardian are prevented from using the prize tickets due to illness, weather, family emergency, or other occurrence or event outside the control of Administrator. Prize tickets will be delivered electronically to the e-mail address provided by the parent/guardian of a winning Contestant during the confirmation process approximately four to six weeks in advance of the applicable race.

GENERAL CONDITIONS: By entering this Contest and/or using any prize, the Contestant and parent/legal guardian agree: (1) to release, discharge and hold harmless Administrator and its parents, subsidiaries, limited liability and affiliated companies, advertising and promotion agencies, and each of their respective shareholders, officers, directors, employees, members, agents and assigns (collectively, the "Released Parties") from liability of any kind or nature for any loss, claims, damages, or injuries of any kind resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly from Contestant's participation in this Contest or from the acceptance and use/misuse of any prize; and (2) to abide by, and be bound by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Administrator relating to participation in the Contest, selection of winners and awarding of prizes, which shall be final. Acceptance of any prize constitutes permission to use winner's name, biographical information, city and state of residence, voice, photograph, image and/or likeness, and the video/essay submitted in the Entry for advertising, promotional and other purposes in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, worldwide, in perpetuity, without further compensation, notification or permission from the Contestant or parent/legal guardian or any third party and without prior notice, approval or inspection, and to execute specific consent to such use if asked to do so, unless prohibited by law. Released Parties are not responsible for lost, interrupted or unavailable network, server, Internet Service Provider (ISP), website, or other connections, availability or accessibility or miscommunications or failed computer, satellite, telephone or cable transmissions, lines, or technical failure or jumbled, scrambled, delayed, or misdirected transmissions or computer hardware or software malfunctions, failures or difficulties, or other errors or difficulties of any kind whether human, mechanical, electronic, computer, network, typographical, printing or otherwise relating to or in connection with the Contest, including, without limitation, errors or difficulties which may occur in connection with the administration of the Contest, the processing or judging of Entries, the announcement of the prize[s], the incorrect uploading of any Contest-related materials. Released Parties are also not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by site users, tampering, hacking, or by any equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest. Released Parties are not responsible for injury or damage to any person's computer related to or resulting from participating in this Contest, or downloading or uploading materials to or from the website or other use of the website. Persons who tamper with or abuse any aspect of the Contest or website, who act in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner or who are in violation of these Official Rules, as solely determined by Administrator, will be disqualified and all associated Entries will be void. Should any portion of the Contest be, in Administrator's sole opinion, compromised by virus, worms, bugs, non-authorized human intervention or other causes which, in the sole opinion of the Administrator, corrupt or impair the administration, security, fairness or proper play, or should the Contest be unable to run as planned for any other reason, Administrator reserves the right at its sole discretion to suspend, modify or terminate the Contest and, if terminated, at its discretion, select the potential winners from all eligible, non-suspect Entries received prior to action taken using the judging procedure outlined above. **CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY DAMAGE THE WEBSITE OR UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE IN VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS AND SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, ADMINISTRATOR RESERVES THE RIGHT TO SEEK DAMAGES AND OTHER REMEDIES (INCLUDING ATTORNEYS' FEES) FROM ANY SUCH INDIVIDUAL TO THE FULLEST EXTENT OF THE LAW, INCLUDING CRIMINAL PROSECUTION. FORUM SELECTION: This Contest shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arizona. The Contestant and parent/legal guardian knowingly and voluntarily intend and agree that (i) the mandatory, exclusive venue for any action in any way related to or arising out of this Contest or prizes awarded shall be resolved individually without resort to any form of class action and shall be the state and federal courts in and for Maricopa County, Arizona; and (ii) any and all claims, judgments and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs

incurred, including costs associated with entering any Contest, but in no event attorneys' fees. The Contestant and parent/legal guardian hereby knowingly and voluntarily waive any and all objections to venue and personal jurisdiction in the foregoing and submit themselves thereto. The Contestant and parent/legal guardian hereby waive any right they may have to assert the doctrine of forum non conveniens or similar doctrine or to object to venue with respect to any proceeding brought in accordance with this paragraph, and stipulates that the aforementioned courts shall have in personam jurisdiction and venue over them for the purpose of litigating any dispute, controversy, or proceeding arising out of or related to this Contest.

CLASS ACTION WAIVER: Each party agrees that an arbitrator, judge, magistrate or other similar authority may not consolidate more than one person's claims, and may not otherwise preside over any form of a representative or class proceeding, and that any dispute resolution proceedings will be conducted only on an individual basis and not in a class, consolidated or representative action. You agree to waive any right to a jury trial or to participate in a class action.

WINNERS' LIST: The name of each winner will be announced on Phoenix Raceway's website and social media channels after confirmation, and will be available on the website through the end of 2027. The names of the winners confirmed in October 2026 through February 2027 will be listed in the NASCAR Spring events weekend program and the names of the winners confirmed in March through September 2027 will be listed in the Fall event weekend program.

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
